1. The shortlisting criteria for admission of M.Tech. Programme in Energy Studies (JES) for Academic session 2018-2019 is given below:

Eligible UG Disciplines	B.Tech. / B.E. in Chemical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Energy Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Engineering Physics, M.Sc. in Physics
GC	GATE Score : ≥ 700 and UG Marks : $\geq 75\%$ or CGPA : $\geq 7.50/10.00$
OBC	GATE Score : ≥ 630 and UG Marks : $\geq 75\%$ or CGPA : $\geq 7.50/10.00$
SC/ST/PH	GATE Score : ≥ 450 and UG Marks : $\geq 55\%$ or CGPA : $\geq 5.5/10.00$
Sponsored Full Time/ Part Time (morning)	(i) Employees of Public Sector Undertakings / Government Organizations / Research & Development Organizations / Private Industries / Academic Institutions (approved by CES Faculty Board). (ii) Minimum six months work experience as on date of registration. (iii) Minimum UG marks for all disciplines is 75 % or CGPA of 7.50/10 for GC/OBC. For SC/ST/PH, UG marks for all disciplines are minimum 55 % or CGPA of 5.5/10. (iv). Organizations of the candidate seeking admission on Part-time basis shall be located within 50 km radius of IIT Delhi. Attempt shall be made to offer the lecture courses in the Morning slots. (v) No Objection Certificate from Employer as per IIT Delhi proforma and sponsorship certificate (if applicable) shall be produced at the time of interview. The candidate without the certificates will not be interviewed. (vi). Candidates with Self-Sponsorship are not considered for admission in the M. Tech. program.

2. CRC approved the eligible disciplines are B.Tech. / B.E. in Chemical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Energy Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Engineering Physics, M.Sc. in Physics.

3. CRC decided not to offer direct admission without interview. For all candidates with B.Tech. from IITs with a CGPA of 8.0 or above, the requirement of qualification through GATE is waived off.

4. Disciplines other than the disciplines listed above or any other combination of streams, have not been considered for admission in M.Tech. program in Energy Studies (JES).

5. If any candidate is fulfilling the above mentioned criteria but he/she has not been called for interview, he/she may contact CES office through phone (11-26591251) or email (hodces@admin.ac.in) for any clarification before interview date. The interview for admission in M.Tech. in Energy Studies will be held on **May 21, 2018** (Monday) in CES office (Room No. V-235).

Note: The candidates are requested to check their eligibility criteria mentioned above. The candidate can get more information including how to calculate aggregate percentage of marks etc. from "Information Brochure" for admission in M.Tech. (www.iitd.ac.in). Candidates who are not meeting the above criteria, will not be allowed to appear for interview.
